#### What is the “STICH” AmeriCorps Program?

- Health-focused AmeriCorps program
- Members are placed at Federally Qualified Health Centers throughout Connecticut and CHCACT
- 10 months, 40 hours/week

#### What’s in it for me?

- \$12,630 Living Allowance
- \$5,815 education award
- Student loan forbearance
- Health insurance (if eligible)
- Child care (if eligible)
- Training opportunities & career advancement
